Our first quarter has been a busy one this year. HFRC staff and volunteers have seen an increase in daily participation with over 90 families visiting HFRC each week. In addition to an increase in attendance, we have also increased our program enhancements with at least one drop-in program being offered each week alongside our usual monthly program offerings.

We have seen huge success with some of these programs including the "Pokemon Trainer Club" which occurs for school-aged children on the last Tuesday of each month, and the "Reading to the Rescue" program where families were invited to come and interact with cats from our local animal shelter. These programs have been very well received, with the rescue program seeing over 60 participants! (See the photo on the last page of this report.)


HFRC is also excited about our newest space, a multi-purpose room in the Arnot Mall, which provides us with more storage and organization, a private meeting space, and a second location to conduct supervised visits. Supervised visits continue to progress although staff turnover has been a challenge. While we were able to quickly fill the gaps in our staffing, it has led to a bit of slowness in program delivery for supervised visits and it is something we plan to correct going forward.


