Message from the Executive Director Successes & Challenges

HFRC was so excited to start our year with a renovation at the Arnot Mall Playroom. After being in the space for two years with the carpet and floor that we inherited from the previous business, it was time for an upgrade and we made the decision to replace the very old floors with new waterproof LVT. You can see in our photos how nice it looks. It is also easier to keep clean and is considered a huge improvement by families that come to our Playroom. It was also a great time for us to open a second bathroom instead of having just one "family" bathroom, making our Playroom more welcoming to the male caregivers that visit us.

Some other successes that we have had so far in 2024 include high attendance at our small group programs and special activities and an increase in the number of supervised visits that we have been able to offer. New connections with key players in our community have made our visit program more successful. We are very pleased with the quality of that program, and with our ability to offer more visits per week than last year.




