Message from the Executive Director Successes & Challenges

HFRC has been hard at work providing strength-based family programming including our very popular and impactful Summer Lunch Program. Once again, HFRC served free lunch to children at Thorne Street Park in Horseheads every weekday throughout July and August. This program remains very successful with many families coming for lunch and staying for our educational program afterward. These programs were provided by HFRC and by other partner organizations including the Food Bank, Library, Family Reading Partnership, River Friends, Snap-Ed, and Tanglewood. We were able to give children access to free books, fresh fruits and vegetables, library programs, pool passes, water safety instruction, nutrition information, and a variety of enrichment activities all free of charge and with no registration required.

Additionally, HFRC hired a new staff member to grow our Parenting Education programs. At the end of August, she offered some very popular sessions on back-to-school tips and in September we rolled out our new weekly Coffee & Chat program that tackles topics like creating routines, helping children with big emotions, and promoting creative play.

HFRC continues to focus on answering our community's needs and training our staff accordingly. Earlier this year, our staff were certified in CPR and First Aid. Now we plan to provide training to expand their ability to offer developmental information and support. Our busy staff are working hard to fit even more into their schedules, and we are so grateful to have such a dedicated team.
